Lane Closures Along Cornelia Avenue In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces lane closure along Cornelia Avenue, north of Shaw Avenue in Fresno for utility work. Work will continue through Friday, Jan. 16, 2026.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

Traffic Shift, Closure, and Detour Information (detour on back page):

Lanes closures along Cornelia Avenue, north of Shaw Avenue in Fresno for utility work.

Signage will be in place to direct traffic. Access to driveways will be maintained for all property owners.

Work will continue through Friday, Jan. 16, 2026.
