



CONSTRUCTION ALERT

Multiple Closures Along F And Fresno Streets In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces multiple closures along Fresno and F streets in Fresno for utility work. Work is scheduled from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. and will continue through Friday, Feb. 13, 2026.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

Closure And Detour Information:

Multiple Closures:

- Lane closures along Fresno Street, between G Street and the northbound State Route 99 to Fresno Street off-ramp;
- Road closure along F Street, between Fresno and Mariposa streets.

Work is scheduled from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. and will continue through Friday, Feb. 13, 2026.

Signage will be in place to direct traffic. Access will be maintained to all property and business owners. Pedestrian access will be restricted in some areas.



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
