



CONSTRUCTION ALERT

Multiple Closures Along Golden State Boulevard And Weber Avenue In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces multiple closures along Golden State Boulevard and Weber Avenue in Fresno for utility work. Work is scheduled from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. and will continue through Friday, Jan. 23, 2026.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

Closure And Detour Information:

Multiple Closures:

- Intermittent lane closures along Golden State Boulevard between Barstow Avenue and Veterans Boulevard;
- Closure along the Weber Avenue cul-de-sac north of McCaffrey Avenue.

Work is scheduled from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. and will continue through Friday, Jan. 23, 2026.

Signage and flaggers will be in place to direct traffic. Access will be maintained to all businesses and property owners.



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
