Multiple Lane Closures Along Golden State Boulevard And Church Avenue In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces multiple lane closures along Golden State Boulevard and Church Avenue in Fresno for road work. Work is scheduled from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. starting Tuesday, Dec. 2, through Thursday, Dec. 4, 2025.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

Closure And Detour Information:

Multiple Lane Closures:

- Lane closures along Golden State Boulevard, between Belgravia and Foundry Park avenues;
- Lane closures along Church Avenue, between Sarah Street and Golden State Boulevard.

Work is scheduled from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. starting Tuesday, Dec. 2, through Thursday, Dec. 4, 2025.

Signage and flaggers will be in place to direct traffic. Access will be maintained for businesses and property owners.
