



CONSTRUCTION ALERT

Material Haul Along Avenue 128, Poplar Avenue, Avenue 144 And State Route 43, And Orange Avenue In Tulare And Kings Counties

Tulare And Kings Counties, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Dragados-Flatiron Joint Venture (DFJV), announces intermittent traffic impacts along Avenue 128, Poplar Avenue, Avenue 144, State Route (SR) 43 and Orange Avenue in Tulare and Kings counties to transport materials to a high-speed rail construction site. Hauling is scheduled from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. starting Monday, Jan. 26 through Sunday, March 1, 2026.

This work is part of Construction Package 2-3 (CP 2-3), the 65-mile stretch of high-speed rail between East American Avenue in Fresno County and one-mile north of the Tulare-Kern County line.

Closure And Detour Information:

Intermittent traffic impacts along Avenue 128, Poplar Avenue, Avenue 144, SR 43 and Orange Avenue in Tulare and Kings counties to transport materials to a high-speed rail construction site.


Hauling is scheduled from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. starting Monday, Jan. 26 through Sunday, March 1, 2026.

Haul Route

Materials will be hauled west on Avenue 128 in Porterville, CA; north on Poplar Avenue, west on Avenue 190, north on SR 43, then west on Orange Avenue to a high-speed rail construction site.
