



CONSTRUCTION ALERT

Intermittent Traffic Impacts Along Avenue 88 In Tulare County

Tulare County, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Dragados-Flatiron Joint Venture (DFJV), announces intermittent traffic impacts along Avenue 88, between State Route (SR) 43 and Road 40 in Tulare County for utility work. Work is scheduled from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. starting Friday, Jan. 9 through Saturday, Jan. 17, 2026.

This work is part of Construction Package 2-3 (CP 2-3), the 65-mile stretch of high-speed rail between East American Avenue in Fresno County and one-mile north of the Tulare-Kern County line.

Closure And Detour Information:

Intermittent traffic impacts along Avenue 88, between SR 43 and Road 40 in Tulare County.

Signage and flaggers will be in place to direct traffic. Drivers should expect delays.

Work is scheduled from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. starting Friday, Jan. 9 through Saturday, Jan. 17, 2026.
