Intermittent Traffic Impacts Along Conejo Avenue In Fresno County

Fresno County, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Dragados-Flatiron Joint Venture (DFJV), announces intermittent traffic impacts along Conejo Avenue, between Topeka and Willow avenues in Fresno County for work on the Conejo Viaduct. Work is scheduled from 4 a.m. to 7 p.m. daily starting Friday, Jan. 16 through Monday, Feb. 2, 2026.

This work is part of Construction Package 2-3 (CP 2-3), the 65-mile stretch of high-speed rail between East American Avenue in Fresno County and one-mile north of the Tulare-Kern County line.
