



CONSTRUCTION ALERT

Intermittent Traffic Impacts Along Conejo Avenue In Fresno County

Fresno County, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Dragados-Flatiron Joint Venture (DFJV), announces intermittent traffic impacts along Conejo Avenue, between Topeka and Willow avenues in Fresno County for work on the Conejo Viaduct. Work is scheduled from 4 a.m. to 7 p.m. and will continue daily through Wednesday, Feb. 25, 2026.

This work is part of Construction Package 2-3 (CP 2-3), the 65-mile stretch of high-speed rail between East American Avenue in Fresno County and one-mile north of the Tulare-Kern County line.

Closure And Detour Information:

Intermittent traffic impacts along Conejo Avenue, between Topeka and Willow avenues in Fresno County for work on the Conejo Viaduct.

Work is scheduled from 4 a.m. to 7 p.m. and will continue daily through Wednesday, Feb. 25, 2026.

Signage and flaggers will be in place to direct traffic.

Drivers should expect delays.

Fog Safety Advisory

Dense fog has been reported in the area, significantly reducing visibility and increasing driving hazards. Construction crews actively monitor weather conditions and follow strict protocols for visibility and fog safety. Please drive cautiously, allow extra travel time, and maintain a safe following distance.
