



CONSTRUCTION ALERT

Hauling Along Road 209, State Route 41, 99, 43, And Grangeville Boulevard In Madera, Fresno And Kings Counties

Madera, Fresno, And Kings Counties, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Dragados-Flatiron Joint Venture (DFJV), announces intermittent traffic impacts along Road 209, State Route (SR) 41, 99, 43 and Grangeville Boulevard in Madera, Fresno and Kings counties to transport materials to a high-speed rail construction site. Hauling is scheduled intermittently from 6:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. starting Monday, Feb. 2 through Saturday, Feb. 28, 2026.

This work is part of Construction Package 2-3 (CP 2-3), the 65-mile stretch of high-speed rail between East American Avenue in Fresno County and one-mile north of the Tulare-Kern County line.

Closure And Detour Information:

Intermittent traffic impacts along Road 209, SR 41, SR 99, SR 43 and Grangeville Boulevard in Madera, Fresno and Kings counties to transport material to a high-speed rail construction site.

Hauling is scheduled intermittently from 6:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. starting Monday Feb. 2 through Saturday, Feb. 28, 2026.


Haul Route

Materials will be hauled from Road 209 in Madera County, south on SR

41, south on SR 99, south on SR 43, and east on Grangeville Boulevard to a high-speed rail construction site.
