



CONSTRUCTION ALERT

Road Closure Along Divisadero Street In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces a road closure along Divisadero Street between G Street and Roosevelt Avenue in Fresno for utility work. Work is scheduled from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. starting Thursday, Jan. 8, and will continue through Wednesday, Jan. 28, 2026.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

Closure And Detour Information:

Road closure along Divisadero Street between G Street and Roosevelt Avenue in Fresno for utility work.

Work is scheduled from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. starting Thursday, Jan. 8, and will continue through Wednesday, Jan. 28, 2026.

Southbound G St To Eastbound Divisadero Street Detour

Traffic along G Street headed to eastbound Divisadero Street will be detoured south on G Street, east on Fresno Street, north on Van Ness Avenue to Divisadero Street.

Westbound Divisadero Street Detour

Traffic will be detoured south on H Street, west on Fresno Street, north on G Street to Divisadero Street.

Signage will be in place to direct traffic. Pedestrian access will be restricted in some areas. Access to all businesses and residents will be maintained.



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
