Intermittent Lane Closures Along H Street In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces intermittent lane closures along H Street, between Belmont Avenue and Divisadero Street in Fresno for utility work. Work is scheduled from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. and will continue through Friday, March 20, 2026.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

Closure And Detour Information:

Intermittent lane closures along H Street between Belmont Avenue and Divisadero Street in Fresno for utility work.

Work is scheduled from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. and will continue through Friday, March 20, 2026.

Southbound H Street Truck Detour

Traffic going southbound on H Street from Palm Avenue will be detoured east on Belmont Avenue, south on Blackstone Avenue, then west on Divisadero Street to H Street.

Northbound H Street To Northbound Palm Avenue Detour

Traffic going along H Street to northbound Palm Avenue will be detoured east on Divisadero Street, north on Blackstone Avenue, then west on Belmont Avenue to Palm Avenue.

Signage will be in place to direct traffic. Pedestrian access will be restricted in some areas. Access to all businesses and residents will be maintained.



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
