



# CONSTRUCTION ALERT

## Hauling Along Avenue 72, Road 120 And Avenue 56 In Tulare County

**Tulare County, Calif.** – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Dragados-Flatiron Joint Venture (DFJV), announces intermittent traffic impacts along Avenue 72, Road 120 and Avenue 56 in Tulare County to transport materials to a high-speed rail construction site. Hauling is scheduled intermittently from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. starting Tuesday, Feb. 24 through Friday, March 20, 2026.

*This work is part of Construction Package 2-3 (CP 2-3), the 65-mile stretch of high-speed rail between East American Avenue in Fresno County and one-mile north of the Tulare-Kern County line.*

### Closure And Detour Information:

Intermittent traffic impacts along Avenue 72, Road 120 and Avenue 56 in Tulare County to transport materials to a high-speed rail construction site.


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#### Haul Route

Materials will be hauled west on Avenue 72, south on Road 120, then west on Avenue 56 to a high-speed rail construction site.
