Intermittent Lane And Shoulder Closures Along Elder Avenue In Kings County

Kings County, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Dragados-Flatiron Joint Venture (DFJV), announces intermittent lane and shoulder closures along Elder Avenue, between 7th and 8 ½ avenues in Kings County for utility work. Work is scheduled from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. starting Friday, Feb. 13 through Monday, Feb. 23, 2026.

This work is part of Construction Package 2-3 (CP 2-3), the 65-mile stretch of high-speed rail between East American Avenue in Fresno County and one-mile north of the Tulare-Kern County line.

Closure And Detour Information:

Intermittent lane and shoulder closures along Elder Avenue, between 7th and 8 ½ avenues in Kings County for utility work.

Signage and flaggers will be in place to direct traffic. Access will be maintained to all residents and property owners.

Work is scheduled from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. starting Friday, Feb. 13 through Monday, Feb. 23, 2026.



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
