



CONSTRUCTION ALERT

Permanent Road Closure Of Lansing Avenue In Kings County

Kings County, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Dragados-Flatiron Joint Venture (DFJV), announces a permanent road closure and construction of two cul-de-sacs along Lansing Avenue between State Route (SR) 43 and Ninth Avenue in Kings County. The closures will go into effect starting Monday, March 2, 2026. Construction schedules are subject to change.

This work is part of Construction Package 2-3 (CP 2-3), the 65-mile stretch of high-speed rail between East American Avenue in Fresno County and one-mile north of the Tulare-Kern County line.

Closure And Detour Information:

Permanent road closure and construction of two cul-de-sacs along Lansing Avenue between SR 43 and Ninth Avenue in Kings County.

Access will be maintained for all property and business owners. Signage will be in place to direct traffic.

The closures will go into effect starting Monday, March 2, 2026.
