



# CONSTRUCTION ALERT

## Hauling Along State Route 43 In Fresno County

**Fresno County, Calif.** – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Dragados Flatiron Joint Venture (DFJV), announces intermittent traffic impacts along northbound State Route (SR) 43 between Davis Avenue and Cole Slough in Fresno County to transport materials to a high-speed rail construction site. Hauling is scheduled intermittently from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. on Thursday, March 19 and Friday, March 20, 2026.

*This work is part of Construction Package 2-3 (CP 2-3), the 65-mile stretch of high-speed rail between East American Avenue in Fresno County and one-mile north of the Tulare-Kern County line.*

### Closure And Detour Information:

Intermittent traffic impacts along SR 43 between Davis Avenue and Cole Slough in Fresno County to transport materials to a high-speed rail construction site.

**Work is scheduled from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. on Thursday, March 19 and Friday, March 20, 2026.**

#### Haul Route

Materials will be hauled northbound on SR 43 to a high-speed rail construction site.

**Trucks will be entering and exiting the construction site located near SR 43. Drivers may experience delays and should proceed with caution. Haul route subject to change. Signage and flaggers will be in place to direct traffic.**



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
