Multiple Sidewalk Closures Along G Street And H Street In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces multiple sidewalk closures along G Street and H Street in Fresno for utility work. Work is scheduled to start Monday, March 2 through Wednesday, March 18, 2026.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

Multiple Closures:


- Sidewalk closures along G Street, between Merced and Mariposa streets;
- Sidewalk closure along H Street, north of Broadway Plaza.

Work is scheduled to start Monday, March 2 through Wednesday, March 18, 2026.

Southbound H Street Pedestrian Detour

Southbound H Street to Fresno Street Underpass via sidewalk will be detoured east on Broadway Plaza, then south on Broadway Street to Fresno Street.

Signage will be in place to direct traffic. Access to all businesses will be maintained.
