Closures Along State Route 99 To Golden State Boulevard On- And Off-Ramps In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces closures of the State Route (SR) 99 to Golden State Boulevard on- and off-ramps in Fresno for road work. Work is scheduled to begin Tuesday, April 7 through Thursday, April 9, 2026.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

Closure And Detour Information:

Closures of the SR 99 to Golden State Boulevard on- and off-ramps in Fresno for road work.


Work is scheduled to begin Tuesday, April 7 through Thursday, April 9, 2026.

Northbound Golden State Boulevard Detour

Traffic going northbound along Golden State Boulevard will be detoured

west along the McKinley Avenue roundabout, west on McKinley Avenue, north on Marks Avenue, then east on Clinton Avenue to Golden State Boulevard.

Signage will be in place to direct traffic. Access will be maintained to all businesses and property owners.
