



# CONSTRUCTION ALERT

## Lane Closure Along Santa Ana And Cornelia Avenues In Fresno

**Fresno, Calif.** – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces a lane closure along Cornelia and Santa Ana avenues in Fresno for utility work. Work is scheduled from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. and will continue through Tuesday, March 31, 2026.

*This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.*

### Closure And Detour Information:

#### Multiple Lane Closures:

- Lane closure along southbound Cornelia Avenue, between Shaw and Santa Ana avenues;
- Lane closure along eastbound Santa Ana Avenue, between Cornelia Avenue and Golden State Boulevard.

**Work is scheduled from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. and will continue through Tuesday, March 31, 2026.**

**Signage will be in place to direct traffic. Access to businesses and residents will be maintained.**
