## Shoulder Closure Along Northbound Weber Avenue In Fresno

**Fresno, Calif.** – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces a shoulder closure along northbound Weber Avenue, between Brawley and Marty avenues in Fresno for utility work. Work is scheduled from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. starting Sunday, March 1 through Tuesday, March 17, 2026.

*This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.*

### Closure And Detour Information:

Shoulder closure along northbound Weber Avenue, between Brawley and Marty avenues in Fresno for utility work.

**Signage will be in place to direct traffic. Access to all businesses and residents will be maintained.**

**Work is scheduled from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. starting Sunday, March 1 through Tuesday, March 17, 2026.**
